ACTIVITIES

The CNR (Compagnie Nationale du Rhône), founded in 1933, received the concession of the most powerful French river by the French Government in 1934, in order to develop and exploit it according to three interdependent missions: electricity production, navigation, irrigation and other agricultural uses.

CNR is France's leading producer of 100% renewable energy. It produces and operates an annual average of over 15 TWh from its mix of hydraulic, wind and photovoltaic installations. As an expert in intermittent energy, it manages the entire value chain and plays a major role on European electricity markets. CNR's capital is mainly public-owned: the Caisse des Dépôts and local authorities hold more than 50% of its shares and Engie, the reference shareholder, 49.97%.

Working for the sustainable development of the Rhône territory is an integral part of its development model, based on the redistribution of part of the value created in the territories where the electricity is produced.
