ACTIVITIES

Under the guidance of the Rhône Préfecture, the Government services coordinate their efforts for both businesses and the territory, in a supporting and advisory role, in compliance with current regulatory procedures.

DREAL:

The Regional Department for the Environment, Development and Housing (DREAL) is the regional division of the Ministry for the Environment, Energy and the Sea and the Ministry for Housing and Sustainable Habitat. DREAL's mission is in particular to control industrial activities that could have an impact on the surroundings or on the environment in general, in the context of regulations governing classified installations for the protection of the environment (ICPE). This public service mission, defined by law, aims to prevent and reduce the dangers and nuisances associated with these installations in order to protect people, the environment, property and public health.

As inspector of classified installations for the protection of the environment, DREAL handles:

- > the regulatory framework: examining applications authorizing the operation of BPIs proposals for operating requirements of industrial installations, examination of cessation of activity applications; examination of manufacturer-provided hazard and impact studies;
- > surveillance and control of industrial installations through on-site inspections;
- > information for operators and the general public.

DDT:

The Departmental Territorial Directorate is responsible for implementing the Government's public policies in the areas of planning, prevention of natural and technological risks, housing, habitat, management and control of social housing constructions, protection and sustainable management of resources and natural environments, improving environmental quality and resulting policing measures, and agricultural and rural economy.

It ensures consistency in the application of these policies at départemental level, based on an overall view of territorial challenges, in an endeavor to achieve territorial balance.

DIRECCTE:

In the Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes region, DIRECCTE (Regional Directorate for Businesses, Consumption, Competition, Work and Employment) is the Government's sole economic and social intermediary for the territory's businesses and institutional players.
